Why e-invoicing?

New e-invoice law in KSA

On May 28th 2021, ZATCA (Zakat, Tax and Customs Authority) published the final Resolution of Controls, Requirements, Technical Specifications, and Procedural Rules for Implementing the Provisions of the E-Invoicing Regulation in the Kingdom of Saudi Arabia. This new e-invoicing project (called Fatoorah) aims to reduce VAT leakage, ensure a smoother transition to cashless economy, reduce fraud and tax evasion.

What is e-invoicing?

An e-invoice is a tax invoice issued in a structured electronic format. Hence, scanned or photocopied invoices are not considered e-invoices.



Who needs to comply?

Taxable persons resident in Saudi Arabia will have to issue and store invoices, debit notes and credit notes in electronic format with predefined data fields for all their transactions. The requirements also apply to third parties who are issuing tax invoices on behalf of resident taxable persons.

According to the resolution, the taxable person is prohibited from using any e-invoice generation solution which is not compliant with the specifications and requirements set by ZATCA.

Implementation Phases

Phase 1 **December 4th 2021**

Taxpayers will be required to generate e-invoices (tax invoices and simplified tax invoices) from a solution connected to the internet, in any electronic format, and store them electronically.

Phase 2 **January 1st 2023**

Integration and Clearance – taxpayers will be required to be integrated with ZATCA's e-invoicing platform.
For Phase 2, ZATCA will give notice to specific taxpayers or industries at least six months in advance.
